ESSAY QUESTIONS

(100 MARKS; 120 MINUTES) (33, 3 MARKS EACH: 40 MINUTES EACH)

You are required to answer <u>ANY THREE</u> of the following five questions in the format of an essay of 1 000 to 1 500 words each (roughly 2-3 handwritten pages each).

- 1. Academics argue that before an occupation can be considered to be "professional" in nature, such an occupation must comply with a number of criteria. Prepare an essay in which you discuss these criteria by expressing your views on whether a South African qualified Chartered Accountant can be regarded to be a professional.
- 2. Prepare an essay in which you comprehensively describe the mechanisms that Scottish accountants utilised to professionalise accounting practice in the mid-1800s.
- 3. By reflecting on the various phases of economic growth that characterised the 20th century, discuss how capitalism emerged to be the world's foremost system of economic control.
- 4. As a field of study, "Accounting History" is sometimes criticised for being incomplete and subjective in nature. Discuss whether you agree with these criticisms and to what extent you believe Accounting History is indeed a valuable field of study.
- 5. By reflecting on the socio-economic and political conditions across Europe and Africa at the time, describe why the "Industrial Revolution" initiated in European territories, rather than in African ones.
