## **QUESTION 1**

- 2.3 Why is it important for learners to study this topic? (5)

- 3.1 Formulate four lesson objectives for a lesson on rural-urban migration for aGrade 6 class. (4)
- 3.2 Using Bloom's Taxonomy, write down <u>five questions</u> you will ask during a questioning episode addressing one of the outcomes listed above. Elaborate on how these questions will challenge thinking at the different levels.

- 3.3 Discuss <u>two</u> types of assessment that can be used during this questioning episode and motivate for your choice of each method. (4)
- 3.4 What possible misconception can learners have on this topic? (2) (20)
