QUESTION 1: MULTILINGUALISM

"South Africa's schools should be using the home language of their students as the medium of instruction. This multilingual approach to education was made law in 1997, and is intended, among other things, to modernize the African languages for routine use in high status functions" (Alexander, 2001: page 1 of 3).

In an essay of about 4 pages, discuss critically the multilingual approach to education in relation to the quotation above. Include in your discussion a consideration of:

- The purpose of a multilingual approach to education
- The current status of African languages in education
- Challenges and benefits of the use of the mother tongue for teachers and learners

QUESTION 2: SOCIOCULTURAL THEORY

"Vygotsky's sociocultural theory of human learning describes learning as a social process and the orientation of human intelligence in society or culture. The major theme of Vygotsky's theoretical framework is that social interaction plays a fundamental role in the development of cognition."

Discuss Vygotsky's sociocultural theory of learning as relevant to language learning. You may make reference to the ZPD, scaffolding, discourse, modelling, and collaborative learning to support your discussion. (100/3)

QUESTION 3: LANGUAGE ACQUISITION

This module covered theories addressing the topic of First language Acquisition and Second Language Learning. Write an essay of 3-4 pages in which you address either of these topics. If you are addressing First Language matters It is expected that you consider the work of one or more of the following: B. F. Skinner, Noam Chomsky, and/or Steven Pinker. If you are addressing Second Language matters it would be expected that you consider one or more of the following: Rod Ellis, Stephen Krashen, and Jim Cummins.

In your essay you need to address central features of the theorists, and comment on their value in language education. (100/3)
