#### **QUESTION 1**

Roxanne's mother is a client in your clinic. She mentions to you that Roxanne's skin has become extremely oily and that she is worried about the possibility of acne. She brings her daughter in for a consultation and you note the following:

- She is 14 years old and began menstruating a year ago
- Her skin is excessively oily with congestion including comedones and blocked pores on her T-panel
- There is **severe dehydration** on the outer contours
- Even though she is excessively oily, her skin is flaky
- She has **sensitivity** on her cheeks.

Roxanne uses Clearasil face wash with and toner and does not use moisturiser because she feels it makes her too oily. She uses a benzoil peroxide cream instead because she saw on TV that this cream will prevent breakouts and she is afraid of getting acne.

Roxanne's mother gives you free reign to set up a treatment programme and there are no budgetary constraints. Roxanne can come in on Tuesdays, Thursdays and Saturday.

You have the following available: full range of professional products, a full selection of galvanic gels, a galvanic unit, a microdermabrasion, an anessonic unit and a pure ultrasound unit.
