QUESTION 1 Kounin's (1997:80) Model for good classroom behaviour [20]

Kounin (1977: 80) believes that learners' good classroom behaviour depends on the type of teaching instruction demonstrated by the teacher. His theoretical model for good classroom behaviour is based on five areas namely: with-it-ness, overlapping, momentum, smoothness and group focus in teaching instruction. Kounin's also emphasises that teachers must be well prepared and organised and, also communicate their instruction effectively to the learners.

- 1.1 Critically evaluate the five areas in the context of teaching in a diverse environment in the South African context. (10)
- 1.2 Give examples on how you would use Kounin's five areas of classroom behaviour management to strengthen your teaching practice? (10)

QUESTION 2 Classroom Discipline
