#### QUESTION 1 Skinner's theory of operant conditioning

According to Skinner (1971), when a particular stimulus-response pattern is reinforced (rewarded), the individual is conditioned to respond. He encouraged immediate praise, feedback and/or reward when seeking to change troublesome behaviour or to encourage correct behaviour in the classroom. He advocated using the merit and demerit system in schools.

- 1.1 Critically evaluate Skinner's theory and assess its relevance in the management of learner behaviour in South African public schools. (10)
- 1.2 Explain how Skinner visualised the ABC of operant conditioning and cite examples from your teaching practice on how you would use "operant conditioning" to strengthen your teaching preparation and practice. (10)

### QUESTION 2 Classroom Discipline

Rogers (1998:11) defines discipline as a "teacher directed activity that seeks to lead, guide, direct, manage or confront a learner about behaviour that disrupts the rights of other learners". Rogers also distinguishes between three types of discipline.

- 2.2 You have 55 learners with different learning abilities in your life skills class. The classroom is structured to accommodate 40 learners only. Explain how you would arrange a classroom environment to create a safe and disciplined teaching and learning atmosphere for your learners.
