QUESTION 2

Regina is 55 years old and is your friend, Tebogo's mother. She never paid much attention to skin care but Tebogo gave her a voucher to come to you for a consultation. During the consultation you determined the following:

- Severe premature ageing
- Extreme sensitivity and deep uneven hyperpigmentation on her cheeks
- Extreme dehydration all over

Regina works as an office administrator but her main hobby is gardening. She does not wear a hat or SPF when she is outdoors. Regina informs you that she used a skin lightening cream that she bought "down town" but that she stopped using it a few weeks ago because it was causing the extreme sensitivity and deep, uneven hyperpigmentation on her cheeks. The consultation also reveals that Regina is menopausal but is not using HRT and is suffering from the common side effects of menopause.

Tebogo is celebrating her 21st birthday in 4 weeks' time and Regina would like to look her best for the party.

You have the following available: a full range of Guinot products, a microdermabrasion unit (MDA), a galvanic unit, a Hydradermie machine and a Photizo.

Regina can come in three days a week and has no budgetary constraints.
