Subjective data:

He had a "chest cold" and was taking various antihistamines and decongestants that brought no relief. He complains of increased difficulty in breathing.

On physical examination:

- dusky nailbeds and mucous membranes and shallow respirations
- temperature 40°C,RR 28, Pulse 114bpm,
- auscultation breath sounds were barely audible in the lower lobes and crackles and rales were heard

Chest X-Ray was suggestive of bilateral lobar pneumonia of the lower lobes.
