Question 1:

Explain any five (5) of the following terms:

Peruvians, Geniza, *Tefillin*, *Yom Kippur*, *Rosh Hashanah*, *mitzvot*, *Halachah*, Holocaust, *Tanakh*, Tikvat Israel (10).

Question 2:

In studying the Torah, the Rabbis were concerned with discovering its underlying ethical purposes. Discuss this point in relation to the ritual of Shechitah, dietary laws, regard for human life, waste, treatment of slaves, theft, sensibilities (20).

Question 3:

Give a detailed account of the two waves of Jewish immigration to South Africa in relation to socio-economic status, religiosity, political persuasions, occupations/professions, and response to Apartheid (20).

Question 4:

- a. Explain a theology of economics in Jewish teachings (10).
- b. Explain in brief Rabbi Susan Grossman's decision to pray with *Tefillin* (10).

Question 5:

- a. Discuss the connotations of Jewish women's names found in the Geniza documents. (10)
- b. Write briefly on the heroic Warsaw Ghetto uprising of 1943 (10).

Explain Santiago Slabodsky's Decolonial Jewish thought (20).
