QUESTION 1 (50)

The timeshare product presents a clear example of the innovative nature of the tourism industry's lodging and accommodation sector. Using the origins, development and evolution of the timeshare product in South Africa, write an essay discussing the reasons for the development of the timeshare product segment, and the benefits and challenges associated with the product that have driven specific types of product innovation in the industry.

OR

QUESTION 2 (50)

Tourism in South Africa has been noted as being vulnerable to the impacts and implications of climate change which require effective adaptation initiatives to be undertaken. In focussing on the different impacts that tourism in South Africa may face, write a detailed essay discussing how climate change may impact on South African tourism, referring to the types of impacts involved, and the main barriers to adaptation that may need to be overcome.

OR

QUESTION 3 (50)

Discuss the statement that VFR travel is underestimated, neglected by researchers but is of critical importance for tourism destinations.

OR

QUESTION 4 (50)

Write an essay discussing some of the benefits of slum tourism. You should include both some of the benefits which have been realized, using specific examples, as well as the potential benefits of slum tourism. Finally, discuss some of the challenges to realizing these benefits.
