## **QUESTION 5**

A site has been identified for the development of business purposes and Town Planning services are required for a successful development.

The site measuring  $90000m^2$  is zoned "Business 1" in terms of the Johannesburg town planning scheme with a height restriction of 3 storeys and floor Area Ratio of 0,8. Basement parking being allowed.

- A dwelling unit is deemed to be 40m<sup>2</sup> in terms of the Johannesburg Municipality Bylaws
- There are 5 restaurants on site measuring  $(3(250m^2), 300m^2 \text{ and } 420m^2)$
- There are 3 shops on site measuring  $5000m^2$  each
- There is 15000m<sup>2</sup> of offices and 1000m<sup>2</sup> medical consult rooms on site.

1. What is the maximum number of dwelling units that can be accommodated on site if the remainder of the area is to be used for residential purposes?

2. What is the residential density in terms of dwellings per hectare?

3. What is the total parking required? Where parking is required at the following ratios: Give a breakdown per use and the total.

- (i) 4 parking bays per 100m<sup>2</sup> offices floor area
- (ii) 6 parking bays per 100m<sup>2</sup> shop floor area

- (iii) 10 parking bays per 100m<sup>2</sup> restaurants floor area
- (iv) 8 parking bays per 100m<sup>2</sup> medical consulting rooms
