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QUESTION 1

Margaret Mackey is a significant Canadian writer in the field of children's literature.

Consider this statement:

Authors create books within their own historical, cultural, and social contexts. We read biographies of authors and literary histories of particular eras or milieus with a view to making sense of how a work relates to the world from which it sprang.

How would our understanding of literate and literary development be altered if we paid equivalent attention to individual readers' social, cultural, and historical contexts? Beginning readers in particular are invested in their own time and space, and also in their own bodies in relatively singular ways. (Mackey 2011)

Write an essay of 2-3 pages in which you reflect on Mackey's opinion, indicating whether you agree or disagree with her position. In your essay state how your position affects how you approach the teaching of children's or young adult's books.

QUESTION 2

South African classrooms are generally made up of mixed abilities learners from various cultural backgrounds, and most of them speak languages other than English as their first language.
