Tsogo Sun, Sun International close Hotels By Edward West, March, 25, 2020

CAPE TOWN - Listed hotel groups Tsogo Sun Hotels and Sun International started closing their hotels and casinos yesterday ahead of the lockdown. Sun International yesterday said it would start closing its hotels and casinos at various times until the end of the lockdown period. It said a handful of essential personnel would remain on the premises to ensure general maintenance and security. The group said it had consulted with unions, employees, suppliers, service providers and concessionaires, and action was being taken to reduce costs during the lockdown. "The full financial impact of the coronavirus on the company will only be able to be determined once the lockdown has been lifted and its ramifications properly assessed," the group said in a statement. However, sources close to the group indicated that the close down was not directly linked to the Corona Virus, but that the hotel has been on a financial nose dive even before the pandemic hit. The Group is said to have started closing some of its operations mid last year. The sources, who refused to be names, also mentioned that Sun Hotels had suffered R59 million by January and 18.7% JSE shares loss.Asked for comment, Tsogo Sun Chief Operations Director refused to give light to the claims warning the writer not to listen to grapevine. He said that all that the public needed to know had already been communicated via the proper channel. For further information, the Chief Operations Director asked the writer to send questions through their spokesperson.
