QUESTION 1:

Democracy is considered by many to be critical to achieving development. Discuss the significance of democracy in the Sub-Saharan "developing countries" from the 1950s to the present. Define your terms.

AND/OR QUESTION 4:

Is it true that Sub-Saharan African countries live in the past? Discuss. Don't forget to include political, economic, social and environmental issues in your discussion.
