SECTION A - DEVELOPMENT DISCOURSE: THEORY and HISTORY

- 1. What are the most important world historical 'moments' that have influenced development discourse and theories? *How* have these transformative periods changed development studies?
- 2. Compare and contrast Julius Nyerere's ideas of African socialism and Peter Ekeh's theory of the 'two publics', in the context of Jawaharlal Nehru's speech at the Bandung Conference in 1955.
- 3. "American development and aid policies were more about the politics of the Cold War than economic advancement for the countries in the 'Third World'". Discuss this assertion, relying mostly on Cullather's 'Development Doctrine and Modernization Theory'.
