Original Assignment Instructions:

Background of Assignment

You will need to form groups of maximum three members. This group configuration is compulsory, and you will need to utilise your group throughout the semester and develop this assignment together. Within these groups you will need to divide the research work and writing up work up amongst the members, so as to make productive use of your and your group member's time.

Students need to develop a focus area from three of the <u>major outcomes of the</u> <u>module</u>. Students then need to formulate a study commencing with a literature review and conducting the study based on the predetermined methodology that were suitable and chosen for the study as guided by the lecturer.

Methodology required from students are on an undergraduate level, and the theory was provided to students during lectures as well as students had to perform their own literature review to expand on this theory and to develop their own basic theoretical framework.

Students then had to develop an interview schedule and interview one entrepreneur in their community that are suitable for their study. From this case they then had to evaluate the application of their theoretical framework within practice.

The Major Topics extracted from the Module Outcomes are as follows:

- Entrepreneur to Business Owner Transition Path
- Rapid Expansion Strategies
- International Strategies and the International Business Environment
- Opportunities of Globalisation
- Family Business environment
- Succession Strategies for Sustainability (Family and Non-Family Business)

The final project needs to be in the form of a research paper which are around 10 pages and in a typed format, and will be assessed at an undergraduate level.
