Question 1

- 1.1 Name and describe five **ways** in which a group can provide **social support** to its members to help them manage during the COVID-19 pandemic. (5)
- 1.2 Describe five **sources of cohesion** that could lead to an increase in the level of cohesion among the members of the COVID-19 Command Council. (5)
- 1.3 What do we call:
 - 1.3.1 the principle of attraction where people tend to join groups that are physically close to them? (1)
 - 1.3.2 the principle of attraction where people tend be attracted to groups whose members they view as sharing the same characteristics? (1)
 - 1.3.3 the principle of attraction where the group expands because members convince their friends to join the group? (1)
 - 1.3.4 the tendency for people to be attracted to groups where they get the highest benefits while having to make the least sacrifices? (1)
 - 1.3.5 the principle of attraction where people tend to like those that they think like them? (1)
- 1.4 Name the following forms of influence:
 - 1.4.1 Influence that is unnoticed and largely automatic. (1)
 - 1.4.2 The use of verbal and nonverbal tactics to promote conformity. (1)

- 1.4.3 When members feel, think, and act in ways that are consistent with their group's social standards. (1)
- 1.4.4 When group members accept information received from another as evidence about reality. (1)
- 1.4.5 The tendency for people to be less likely to assist someone in distress if others are present. (1)
- 1.5 The presence of others could have a positive or negative effect on the performance of individuals. Sports events are now beginning to take place again but without any audience present. Explain how the **absence** of an audience could affect sports individuals' achievement and why. (5)

Describe the **preceding conditions** that could lead to the development of **groupthink** among this group, analyse the **symptoms** of groupthink that might be present and advise the President about ways in which he could ensure that groupthink is **prevented**. (10)
