QUESTION 1:

The National Research Foundation (NRF) has asked you to conduct research on the experiences of Sociology students enrolled at UJ and their experiences of online learning during the Covid-19 pandemic. This study aims to understand how five male and five female students experience learning online, what challenges they experience, and how they overcome them. In your research, you need to include the following:

a) Critically explain why a qualitative methodological approach is appropriate for this study.

- b) Explain how you will select five male and five female Sociology students from UJ utilising a non-probability sampling technique. Explain the advantages and disadvantages of the chosen sampling method and how you will overcome these challenges. [6]
- c) Explain why a semi-structured interview to collect data is appropriate and how you will analyse the data, considering that you need to adhere to the safety measures of the Covid-19 protocols? Use examples to substantiate your answer. [7]
- d) Explain how you will ensure this study fulfils all the ethical requirements of a sociological sound research project. Use examples to substantiate your answer. [5]

or QUESTION 2:

There has been an increase in female students who graduate with an Honours degree in Sociology from UJ. The study aims to explore the views of 10 students who have graduated with an Honours degree in Sociology on why they have studied Sociology, what skills they have gained during their studies, and what type of jobs they get after graduating. In your research, you need to include the following:

a) Critically explain why a qualitative methodological approach is appropriate for this study.

- b) Explain how you will select 10 female students from UJ utilising a non-probability sampling technique. Discuss the advantages and disadvantages of the chosen sampling method, and how you will overcome these challenges. [6]
- c) Explain why a structured interview to data collection is appropriate and how you will analyse the data, considering that you need to adhere to the safety measures of the Covid-19 protocols? Use examples to substantiate your answer. [7]
- d) Explain the difference between confidentiality and anonymity. How would you ensure confidentiality in a qualitative study? Give examples to substantiate your answer. [5]
